**Community Awareness Outreach** - Each month, outreach teams of trained volunteers distribute posters of vulnerable, missing minors to strategic business locations throughout our local area to bring awareness of missing children. This year volunteers will fill the first two weeks of June (Week One: 6/1-5; Week Two: 6/8-12) and the first full week of July (Week Three: June 29-July 3). Volunteers hand out meals (and sometimes small items such as books, bubbles, sidewalk chalk or toys) at the GRACE Food Pantry location from 11:45 a.m. -12:45 p.m. each weekday.
